Mistletoe therapy makes a major contribution to oncological therapy. It is increasingly being practised, but is still considered unconventional by many. It combines traditional and new knowledge for the benefit of patients. Accordingly, the 8th Mistletoe Symposium in November 2023 focussed on new research: The focus of the clinical part was therefore on oncological immunotherapies in combination with mistletoe therapy. The more than 100 participants presented current data from relevant areas of biology, pharmacy and pharmacology, preclinical and clinical research, findings from therapeutic experience and clinical studies. Non-oncological applications of mistletoe and its use in animals were also discussed.

Die Mistel in der Tumortherapie 6 documents this symposium and all available contributions. The summaries in German and English preceding each article provide a good overview of the respective topic. All articles are illustrated with graphics, diagrams and photos. Detailed bibliographies and correspondence addresses facilitate further, in-depth work.

The symposia and their subsequent book publications are intended as a forum for joint discourse, bringing together biological, pharmaceutical and clinical expertise in order to exploit synergies and further expand the dialogue and cooperation between conventional and integrative oncology.

The book, like its predecessors (see below), is an important reference work for anyone who wants to find out about the current state of theoretical and practical knowledge and clinical evidence on mistletoe therapy.
